

Supporting our Community

With 42 years in service and counting, Ministry with Community has adapted to changes and met challenges many times. In fact, it's one of the things we do best, and one of the reasons we've been around for so long.

The challenge of COVID-19 has us adapting once again as we face new changes daily, and sometimes hourly. Unfortunately, the first major change we made was the decision to cancel Chefs Against Hunger, our largest annual fundraiser. It was a clear, but difficult, choice to make. The clear part was keeping people safe.

The difficult part was that we knew we would lose a significant amount of funding. Canceling the event was at least a \$20,000 loss to our operating budget.

Though we were disheartened to lose Chefs Against Hunger, we have been met with generosity from both new and longstanding supporters. To those who have reached out, we thank you!

The next change we are facing is the possibility of serving more people with fewer volunteers. Many of the wonderful individuals who donate their time to us are safer at home, and we fully support them. Following guidelines from the State of Michigan, the CDC, and the Kalamazoo County Health Department, we are also actively limiting the number of people in our building.

Yet, in the center of these unexpected developments, we are continuing to support our community. In addition to meeting our members' needs, we have a Census kiosk that you can read more about inside this newsletter. By ensuring that our members are counted in the Census, we are helping to secure vital funding to our city and state.

Also in this edition of our newsletter, you will find a step-by-step guide to using our website to set up monthly giving. Financial support is particularly critical at this time, and donating through our website is an easy way to make a difference from the comfort and safety of your home.

Recurring Gifts Help Keep Good Intentions Intact

How did you ring in the New Year? For the second year in a row, I found myself online shortly before the ball dropped. Once again, I was making a last-minute donation to one of the nonprofits I love to support.

This time, however, I decided to do something different. Instead of making one gift, I set up a recurring, monthly donation.

I'm a fundraiser, but I'm also a donor. I understand how life's obligations can cause us to put our good intentions on hold (even more so now that I'm a parent!). That's why I've started signing up for recurring gifts when I contribute.

At Ministry with Community, we love recurring donors! They provide support we can count on throughout the year. We open our doors every day of the year, so steady income makes a difference.

How to set up a recurring gift

You can set up your recurring gift in a few steps:

- **1.** Go to ministrywithcommunity.org, and click on the big DONATE button in the middle of the page
- **2.** This will take you to our secure, donate page. This can also be found at ministrywithcommunity.org/makeadonation.
- **3.** Under the Amount, click the checkbox, which opens a drop-down menu.
- **4.** Choose the Frequency (Weekly, Monthly, Quarterly, Yearly) and enter the Start Date for your gift.
- **5.** Enter the Dollar Amount you want to give for each installment. For example, if you want to give \$25/month, simply enter \$25.
- **6.** Enter your contact and credit card information as you would with any online gift.

Feel free to call or email me with questions or if you'd like me to set up a recurring gift for you. I'm happy to help with this at any time—even if you wait till New Year's Eve.

Census 2020

Every Member Counts

Did you know that every Michigander who goes uncounted in the U.S. Census can cost the State of Michigan \$1,800 per person per year for 10 years? An accurate Census count helps ensure that the federal tax dollars we send to Washington D.C. make it back to Michigan and Kalamazoo County.

People experiencing homelessness, poverty, mental illness and other challenges are at extremely high risk of going uncounted in the Census. That's why Ministry with Community is hosting a Census kiosk in our facility. The kiosk is volunteer-run and will be open during scheduled days and times between March 13 and April 2.

At Ministry with Community, the Census is about more than doing our civic duty and ensuring future funding in Kalamazoo County. It helps us deliver an essential message.

"Sadly, some of our members are made to feel unwelcome in their own community," said Kelly Henderson, Executive Director of Ministry with Community. "We are always trying to show each person how much they matter and how much we care about them. The Census is another opportunity for us to deliver that message to our members: You matter. You count. Your response is just as important as the next person's."
